June PTO Meeting 6/13/2023 7pm in the BES Library

Handouts for the Playground presentation:

Lori K. - Playground. Same company that Dunbarton Elementary used for their upgrade. Lori met with the representative. 2 options, one of which would replace the current large structure. Big piece 1st. Price includes take away, set-up and wood chips. Can reduce by \$5,000 if we remove ourselves. Spreading the wood chips ourselves will also lower the cost.

2 quotes. Lori wanted something less easy to hide in, also option 1 has ramp instead of stairs for anyone with mobility challenges. There are various color options. Ramp is an option for either design.

\$42,000 from the Glow Run \$3,139 from BES activities account Total: \$45,139

Looking to raise \$ with Rotary and local businesses to help with add on pieces. Rotary would like to help but are not ready until the Fall.

Cost for Option 1 is 177 votes, Option 2 is 185 votes

So OPTION 2 with a Ramp included is the Winning Design

If ordered this week. Can be breaking ground in Nov/Dec. More fundraisers are coming, such as Fun Run Wednesday before vacation next year.

Lori is proposing that PTO cover the difference from what we raised already.

Lori is also proposing that in the future fundraisers can help fund the PTO once the playground is finished.

Bianca is saying that the budget needs to be reviewed because half of what we used to have in the budget is no longer appropriate. In the future we need to decide where the \$ is going. Because the PTO covers all 3 schools.

Lori proposed that maybe for certain field trips we use something other than our bus system. Transportation is such a challenge. So perhaps that is an area that PTO funds can be used.

Voting:

For this vote it is filling in what is needed. ~\$46, 000. Bylaws state that everyone present can vote. Voting by paper vote. Motion will be worded (not to exceed \$90,000 inclusive of the \$42,000 that is currently in the PTO account but already earmarked for the playground).

PTO is voting YES donate to the playground (not to exceed \$90,000) or NO not to donate the \$ to the playground.

VOTE Results: MOTION PASSES 16 YES 3 NO

There needs to be more involvement in all of the fundraisers, not just the BES fundraisers. The board is saying that the middle and high school have less involvement and help overall with their fundraisers. Increased communication going forward will help to ensure that there are more volunteers for future events at all the schools.

Budget Process: Kim Martin has volunteered to assist with the budget.

Donations will go to support funeral expenses. By June 23rd. Bianca will look into the fund to help families who lose a child.
